



## **Regulation on the radiomathon in support of the 16th international environmental campaign "To Save and Preserve"**

In the framework of the 16th International Environmental Campaign "To Save and Preserve" in the Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug– Yugra the regional branch of the Russian Radio Amateurs Union of KhMAO-Yugra in cooperation with the Government of the Okrug conducts the Radiomathon "To Save and Preserve" in May – June 2018. Radio amateurs from all around the world are invited to participate.

### **1. General information about the International Environmental Campaign "To Save and Preserve"**

International Environmental Campaign "To Save and Preserve" is a large-scale socially important environmental project conducted in the Autonomous Okrug since 2003. Since 2004 it is held under the auspices of UNESCO and the International Association "The Northern Forum".

Organizing Committee carries out the coordination of the project activities. The Chairman of the Organizing Committee is the Deputy Governor of The Autonomous Okrug.

**Purpose of the project:** promoting the sustainable development of the region through interregional and international cooperation in the field of environmental protection in order to ensure environmental safety and quality of life, as well as the ecological culture formation of the population. The project contributes to attracting attention of the general population to the Autonomous Okrug environmental problems and the active involvement of citizens in environmental and ecological education. The peculiarity of this project is the variety of organizational forms and tools used for the formation of ecological culture.

The topic of the Campaign is appointed annually based on actual environmental problems in the region for this period. **The topic of the Campaign** in 2018: "Waste management as an urgent environmental problem requiring solution".

## 2. Terms

Start date: 07:00 UTC May 18, 2018.

End date: 18:59 UTC June 8, 2018.

## 3. General provisions

3.1 The main goal of the radio marathon is to attract the world radio amateur community to the issues of rational nature management, environmental protection and ensuring environmental safety.

3.2. During the radiomarathon, 12 special amateur radio stations on the territory of the Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug - Ugra will be on air.

3.3. A special award program is designed to reward the most active participants of the campaign.

3.4. At the end of the radiomarathon, all participants will receive QSL- cards.

QSL Cards will be sent automatically for Russian radio stations which are members of the Russian Radio Amateurs Union and QSL Bureau subscribers.

For QSL request international correspondents can use the bureau OQRS on the website <https://clublog.org/>. It is not necessary to send your QSL-cards.

3.5. The organisation and coordination of the special stations work, the control over the manufacture and dispatch of QSL cards as well as the issuance of awards is carried out by the council of the regional branch of SRR in KhMAO-Yugra.

## 4. Award program

The award program "To Save and Preserve" includes a basic award and a plaque. Awards are given for QSO / SWL with special radio stations on the days of activity from May 18 to June 8, 2018.

You can score: Two-way QSO / SWL, made on any amateur HF, VHF and UHF bands, any kind of mode (CW, PHONE, DIGI). Repeated QSO / SWL on different bands, and on the same band by different modes - CW, SSB, DIGI (all digital modes score as one type of work).

### **Scoring:**

For QSO / SWL with the main special station

R16UGRA Nizhnevartovsk (HM-07); - **15 points**.

For QSO / SWL with special stations:

R16JHM-Khanty-Mansiysk (HM-01)-**10 points**;

R16JNV-Nizhnevartovsk (HM-07)-**10 points**;

R16JSU-Surgut (HM-12) settlement Bely Yar (HM-22)-**10 points**;

R16JNG-Nyagan (HM-08)-**10 points**;

R16JRA-Rainbow (HM-11)-**10 points**;  
R16JLA-Langepas (HM-04)-**10 points**;  
R16JMG-Megion (HM-05)-**10 points**;  
R16JSV-Sovietskiy (HM-21), Yugorsk (HM-14)-**10 points**;  
R16JIG-Igrim (HM-16)-**10 points**;  
R16JUR-expedition to Urai (HM-13)-**10 points**;  
R16JKR-expedition to Kondinsky district (HM-17)-**10 points**.

**Tentative date** of the radio expedition to Uray (HM-13) and Kondinsky district (HM-17) is from 01.06 to 03.06 2018.

Points of the radio amateurs from North and South America, Africa, Australia and Oceania are multiplied by 2.

To obtain the basic award "To Save and Preserve", you need to score **125** points. The QSO/SWL with a special station **R16UGRA** is **obligatory** for receiving the award.

To receive the plaque "Save and Preserve" you need to score **345** points. It is **mandatory** to make QSO/SWL with ALL special stations (altogether 12 stations) for receiving the plaque.

**Five radio amateurs, who score the highest points at the end of days of activity, will be awarded special prizes from the Prirodnadzor Yugra.** SWL cannot participate in this contest.

Checking the connections for the award and the plaque is carried out on the specially created section <http://r9j.hamlog.ru>.

The basic award is issued in electronic form, free of charge, automatically and only on the basis of the downloaded log to the service hamlog.ru.

**The price of a plaque with transfer:**

- For radio amateurs in Russia - 1300 RUR;
- For radio amateurs from other countries - 30 USD or 25 EUR (it is possible to pay in RUR at the exchange rate of the Central Bank of the Russian Federation on the dispatch day). Send your applications to the award manager, contact details are listed below.
